Shaw Rocket Prize finalists announced

The Shaw Rocket Fund, the not-for-profit corporation dedicated to supporting Canadian youth and family television programming, has announced the five finalists for this year's \$50,000 prize awarded to the best Canadian program targeted to children between the ages of six and 12.

A jury of industry experts in children's television and media selected the finalists, which include *Dino Dan* (Sinking Ship Entertainment, broadcasters TVO, Knowledge Network, Access), *How to be Indie* (Heroic Film Company, broadcaster YTV), *In Real Life* (Apartment 11 Productions, broadcaster YTV Canada), *Jimmy Two Shoes* (Breakthrough Entertainment, broadcaster Teletoon Canada) and *League of Super Evil* (Nerd Corps Entertainment, broadcasters YTV, VRAK).

The judging is now passed on to a jury of Canadian children who will select the winner of the 2010 Shaw Rocket Prize from these five finalists. This announcement will be made on November 30 in Ottawa, Canada.
